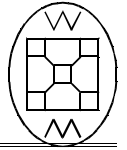

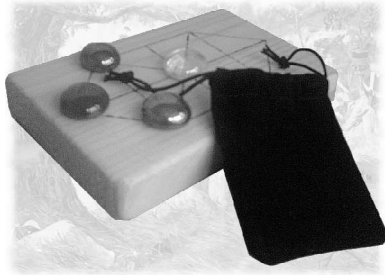

### THE FRENCH MILITARY GAME

Practise your tactical skill with this elegant game from the nineteenth century. Three hunters try to trap their prey. Will the hunt be successful or will the prey escape?

This French Military Game board is made from pine, and is approximately 5 inches by 3 (125mm by 75mm). The pattern is burned into the wood with the poker work technique, so it should not fade. The board is varnished and polished with beeswax. There are four pieces, three hunters and one prey, all of glass. The game comes with a black velvet pouch bag to hold the pieces, and an A4 rules leaflet containing a history of the game.



### BRANDUB

Step back into the Viking age, with brandub, an Irish version of the hnefatafl game that was carried with the Norsemen on their journeys of conquest. Can the king escape the fray, or will his enemies take him?

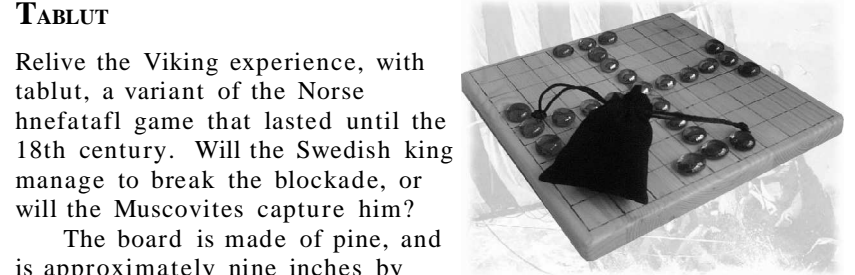
The board is made of pine, and is about 8 inches by 8, or 200 millimetres square. The pattern has been burnt into the wood by hand, so it will never wear, and the wood has been polished with beeswax. There are thirteen glass pieces: one king, four guards and eight attackers. Also included in the sale is a black velvet drawstring bag to hold the pieces, and a 4- page rules leaflet.



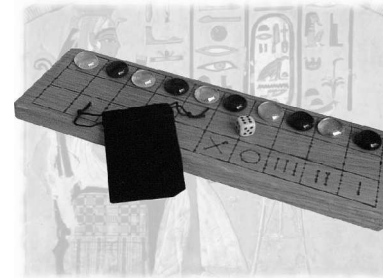
### TABLUT

Relive the Viking experience, with tablut, a variant of the Norse hnefatafl game that lasted until the 18th century. Will the Swedish king manage to break the blockade, or will the Muscovites capture him?

The board is made of pine, and is approximately nine inches by nine, or 225 mm square. The pattern is burnt into the wood, as with other games we make. The pieces are made of coloured glass, and there are two colour sets available: summer and winter. Summer looks the most attractive, but winter is better for colour-blind players. A black drawstring pouch is supplied to keep the pieces.



### SENET



Enjoy a pastime of the ancient Egyptians: senet, a game of luck and strategy that has entertained for 5,000 years. Be the first to move your pieces around the course, in a journey to the afterlife.

This senet board is about 4 inches by 10, or 100mm by 250mm, and is made of oak, polished with beeswax. The pattern is burnt into the wood with the pokerwork technique, so the pattern will never wear. There are ten pieces made of glass, five of each colour. An ivory effect die is supplied, as is a velvet drawstring pouch for the die and pieces. The game is supplied with a 4- page A5 rules leaflet that contains a brief history of the game.
